

AWARD NOMINATION FOR OUTSTANDING GRADUATING SENIOR

What is the award?

The Outstanding Graduating Senior Award is given to a senior graduating student with outstanding contributions to the School of Natural Resources, the community, and the study of natural resources. Selection will be based on grade point average, university and community activities, scholarships and awards.

Who can be nominated?

Any student who is graduating from the School of Natural Resources during the current academic year

Who can nominate?

Nominations of candidates for the Outstanding Graduating Senior may be made by students, faculty, or staff in the School. For assistance with nominations, see the current chair of the SNR Awards Committee (John Koprowski, BSE 306, 626-5895, squirrel@ag.arizona.edu).

Information to be submitted with the nominating petition:

It is incumbent on the nominator to do a particularly careful and thorough job of documenting the petition. Information recommended is:

1. Name of student.
2. GPA.
3. Date of graduation.
4. List of university and community activities.
5. List of scholarships and awards.
6. Signed petition outlining the nominee's qualifications for this award.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

An Award Committee, composed of student, faculty, and staff representatives, has been appointed by the School Director. The committee will select the award recipient based on nomination petitions submitted to the Business Manager. It is possible this award will not be presented annually.
